



DESTINATION

Over an one hour's flight from Bangkok and Hanoi is the beautiful and untouched nation of Laos. A country still relatively closed to the rest of the world, it has just in the last few years opened its doors to tourism. Land locked and surrounded by China, Myanmar, Thailand, Cambodia Vietnam, this small nation is rich in culture and heritage. Luang Prabang, is located in north central Laos, on the Mekong River, about 425 km north of Vientiane. It was the royal capital and seat of government of the Kingdom of Laos. The city is also notable a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

The Lodge features 20 private canvas tents, purposely built to provide unique accommodation these have been specially imported from South Africa . Each one is protected from the elements by a thatch roof and feature solar power

electricity. With attached stone bathrooms providing hot water and flushing toilets , aptly furnished comfortably with bamboo and rattan furniture and all have private balconies,overlooking the river.

All meals taken in Kamu lodge are dined AL fresco, natural materials are used for building these unique outlets, seated on stilts high above the ground in local architectural style. Meals

are traditional Lao cuisine served with true Kamu hospitality. The Bar is a perfect place to unwind and relax after a tiring day trekking in the surrounding landscape. relax and have a cool refreshing cocktail or beer.
